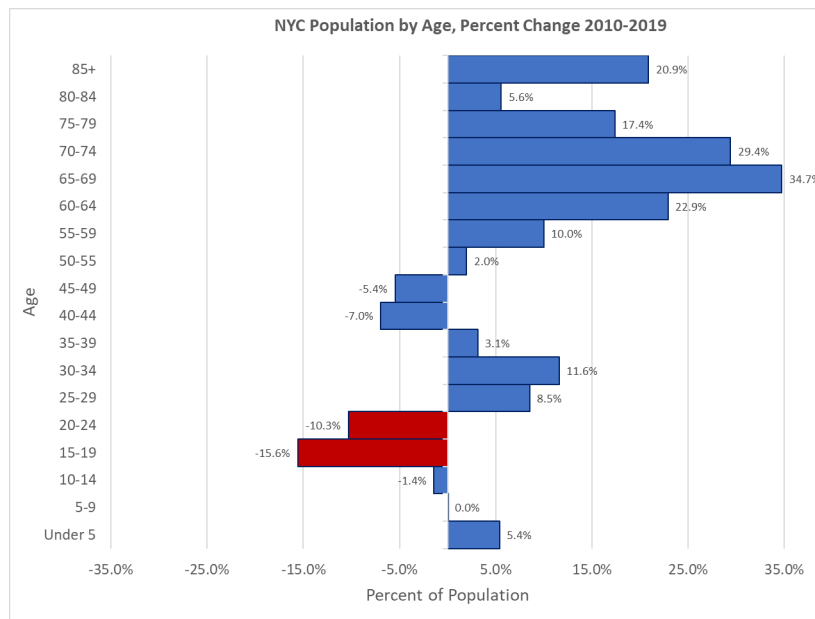
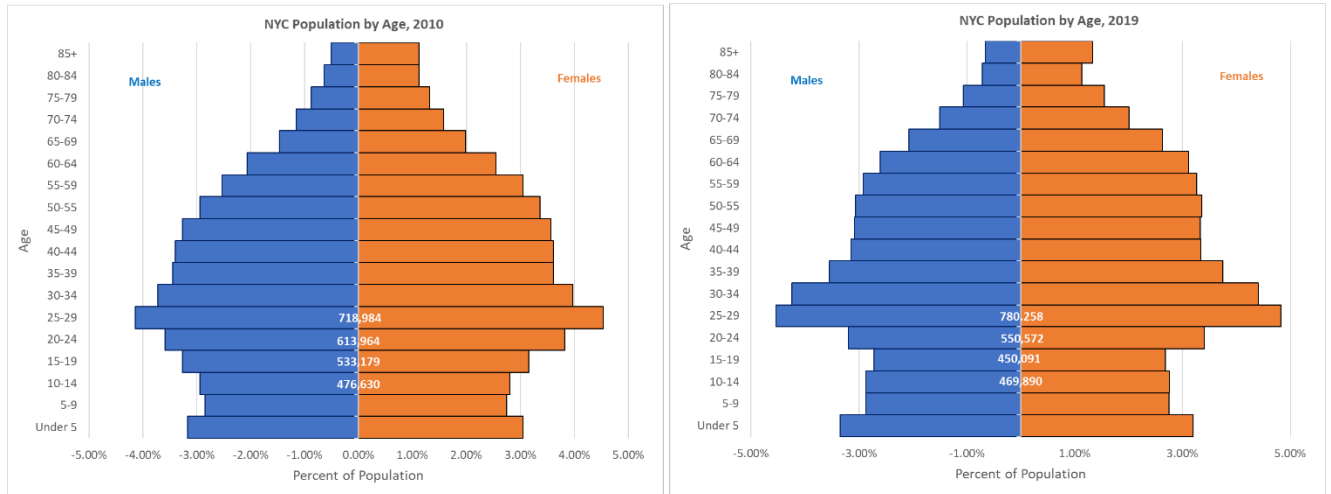


Decline in Traditional College Age Students

We have seen local and national population declines among traditional college-age students. In New York City since 2010, there has been a 10% drop in the 20–24-year-old age cohort and a 16% drop in the 15-19-year-old age cohort. The largest age cohorts in New are now between the ages of 25 and 34. Meanwhile, the pandemic seems to have changed public perceptions about the value proposition of higher education and accelerated trends toward online instruction, particularly at the graduate level and among working adults.
